## What is the APG?

The Atlanta Photography Group (APG) is a non-profit, volunteer organization that promotes and supports contemporary photography as a fine art within Atlanta, Georgia.

It hosts exhibitions, critiques and special events at the APG Gallery throughout the year.

All events are initiated, supported, and promoted by the efforts of individual APG members.

Anyone may join the Atlanta Photography Group and participate in any of its events. A membership form is available on the back of this flier.

All exhibitions are free and open to the public. Monthly critiques are free and open to all who share an interest in photography. A list of regularly scheduled events appears below.

## APG Exhibitions

The APG Gallery hosts approximately six exhibitions a year, each lasting about six weeks. Most exhibitions are juried by well-known and respected gallery owners or experts in fine art photography.

The annual "Push Pin" is a popular non-juried event open to local photographers who are invited to bring un-matted prints and attach them to the gallery walls with push pins. A small entry fee is charged at the door.

The "Photographer's Choice" show is an annual opportunity for all APG members to show their work.



## A Brief History

The Atlanta Photography Group was founded in 1986 by a group of 16 photographers and collectors. Meetings were held in members' homes on a monthly basis to share information and to show and critique work.

The first gallery exhibition space opened in 1988. APG moved to the Tula Arts Center in 1992.

In 1999, the group relocated to larger quarters at 660 9th Street, in the heart of the Atlanta Photo District.

APG returned to the Tula Art Center in 2002.

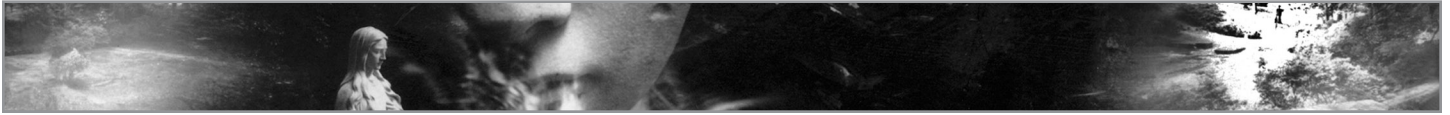

APG supports other events every month. Regularly scheduled events appear below.

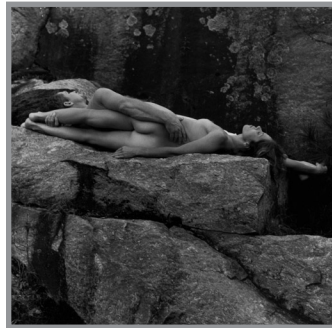
